Evaluation of the Application	Acceptance is not guaranteed even if the student had been selected by their home institution. All applications must be reviewed by the chosen academic department and this may take several weeks. Official acceptance documents will be available online on the <u>Student</u> <u>Center</u> (Centre étudiant) once the application has been accepted by the academic department.

Program of Study and Courses	Students must choose courses from a single program of study (one elective course per term is permitted). Please see the <u>list of programs with particular</u> requirements before nominating students. A <u>full-time course load</u> is mandatory. Programs and courses offered at UdeM > Courses schedule >
Credit System	Bachelor: 1 UdeM credit = 2 ECTS Master and PhD: 3 UdeM credits = 8 to 10 ECTS
Transcript of Records and Grading Scale	Official transcripts can be ordered at the <u>Registrar's Office</u> . Please note that fees apply. See here for the grading scale of UdeM >
Faculty Fees	Additional fees may be directly added to the student's bill on the Student Center at the request of the academic department to cover course materials, equipment use or laboratory access. Additional fees for language courses are to be expected and can vary depending on the nature of the course and the responsible faculty.

## Language Requirement

Université de Montréal is a French-taught institution and most courses are given in French. Proof of a minimum of B2 level French proficiency (from the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)) is therefore required. Some programs of study may require a higher level and official tests; see the list of programs with particular requirements for further details.

Students who are not from a French-speaking institution must provide proof of French proficiency delivered by the language centre of their home university, French Alliance, language schools, etc.

**French courses:** Non-French-speaking students can take one 3-credit French language course per term offered by UdeM's <u>École de français</u> (students will be charged around 75\$ for course materials).

A placement test will be required; information will be provided to students once admitted. Please see <u>our</u> <u>website</u> for further details.

## Immigration

It is the student's responsibility to ensure that immigration requirements are met and that they carry out the **necessary** <u>immigration procedures</u> to study abroad at UdeM as soon as they are accepted.

Procedures and timeframes may differ according to the student's nationality, the length of the exchange and the activities to be undertaken during their stay.
